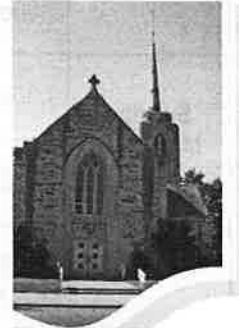

**Reflections from Deacon Mike Stratman**

**Looking Down on Others**

There was a survey conducted by Newsweek magazine about hiring practices that had some startling statistics. Fifty-seven percent of hiring managers believe an unattractive but qualified job candidate would have a harder time getting hired! Eight-four percent of managers said their bosses would hesitate before hiring a qualified older candidate. Sixty-four percent of hiring managers said they believe companies should be allowed to hire people based on appearance. All are examples of unacceptable prejudice.

Prejudice is not new. In the early church, prejudice crept in and St. James addressed this issue head on. In chapter 2, Sin of Partiality, James wrote "My brothers and sisters, show no partiality as you adhere to the faith in our glorious Lord Jesus Christ...however, if you obey the law according to the Scriptures, 'You shall love your neighbor as yourself,' you will be doing well. However, if you show partiality (or prejudice), whether to the rich or the poor, you commit sin." Don't we all need God's grace and forgiveness!

We fight the sin of prejudice by looking up to Jesus on the way He lived and that will help us from looking down on others. Who has helped you determine what the right way to treat people is? Was it based on external things? What are some ways you can love people as Jesus did? Something to ponder on!

**Help Jesus in Disguise!**

Dear Sisters and Brothers,

Have you ever felt lonely? And I'm not talking about being home alone by yourself (which can be one of the greatest feelings in the world!). I'm talking about the feeling that your life is completely detached from others. That you have no one to talk to about your fears or your joys. That you want to pick up the phone and call someone, but you have no one to call. That you are utterly alone.

Well, ironically, you're not alone in feeling alone. There is a growing trend in our society of individuals who experience this feeling on a regular, if not daily, basis. We see it all the time. A teenager who feels like no one can possibly understand what he's going through cuts himself just to feel something, even if it is just pain. A husband and father falls out of love with his wife and has an affair in the hopes of filling the gaping hole in his heart. They divorce soon afterward. A single, middle-aged woman cries herself to sleep at night because she has no family to call her own. A priest leaves his ministry in the hopes of finding fulfillment with a young woman. A teenage girl commits suicide because she thinks nobody loves her.

In so many ways, loneliness is at the heart of our world's woes. Its not greed or pride or lust. It's the fear of being alone.

In his talk on the family, Pope Francis recognizes just how prevalent and powerful loneliness is. And it is a paradox. Because people fear loneliness, they are afraid of entering a committed relationship that could break their hearts and leave them alone. Because people dread being alone, they get on Facebook and Twitter and social media, trying desperately to stay connected, all the while losing any semblance of intimacy or love. Because people are running away from loneliness, they end up running toward depression, anxiety, and, of course, deeper loneliness. As Billy Joel once wrote, "They're sharing a drink they call loneliness, but it's better than drinking alone."

But as the Beatles so wisely asked, "All the lonely people; where do they all come from?" And the answer is quite simple. They come from our own forgetfulness that we are never quite alone.

"I am with you always, even unto the end of the world."

That's a promise. And more than a promise. It's a covenant. It's our God making an impossibly wonderful guarantee that during every moment of our life--every heartache, every teardrop, every loss, every death, every birthday, every Christmas, every good day, and every bad day-- for all of it, he is there for us. All we have to do is take one step in his direction...one step! And like the father of the prodigal son, our God will sprint toward us, wrap his arms around us and say, "I love you."

Loneliness is a choice. Our choice. There's someone out there who wants nothing more than to love you. All you have to do is let Him.
