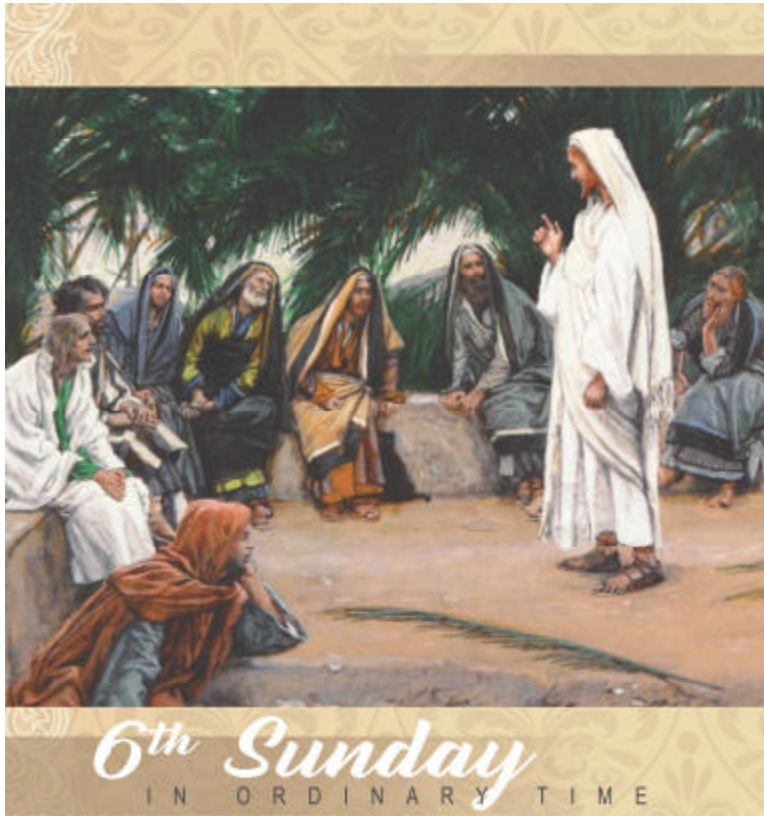

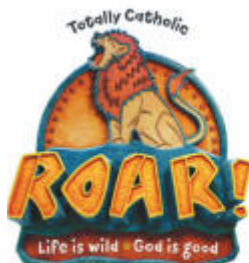
Natural Family Planning (NFP)
