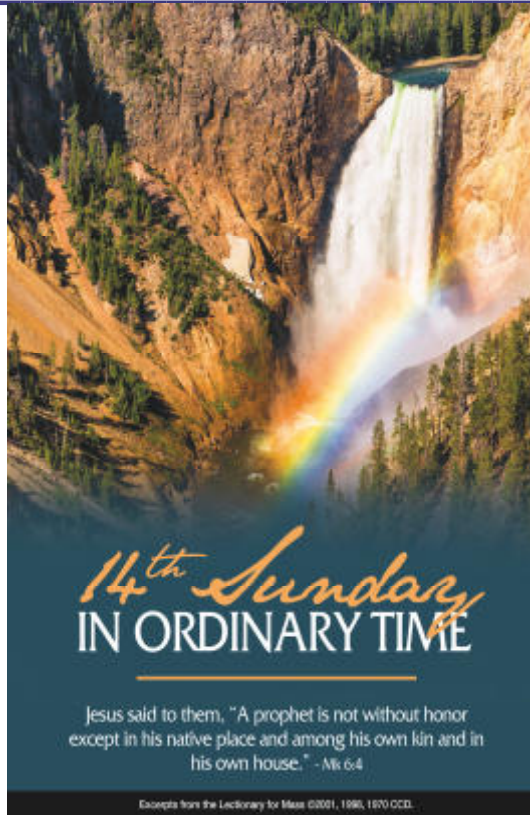

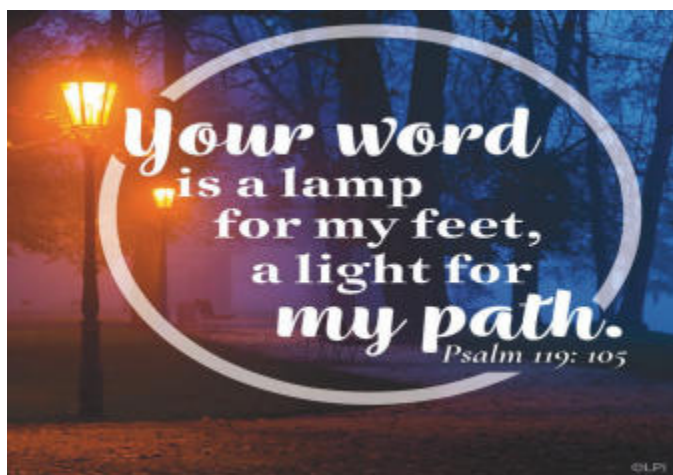
The next meeting of the high school confirmation prep class is on **Wednesday, July 7th, from 7:30-8:45 p.m.**
