

1. May 19 we will reopen churches for daily Mass. Normal Mass schedule afterward.
2. 65 and older are strongly recommended to stay home
3. 30% capacity in church
4. If we reach capacity, all others will be asked to watch the Mass online. If they want to stay in their cars in the parking lot and wait for Mass to finish, they can come in after everyone else has left to receive communion.
5. If you have a mask, wear it. If not, we're hoping to have some available at church, but supplies are limited.
6. Same with hand sanitizer. If you have your own, bring it. If not, we do have a limited supply at the church.
7. Social distancing will be observed.
8. No sign of peace.
9. Only one line for communion. Please remain 6 feet apart. Body of Christ only. It is strongly recommended not to receive on the tongue. Hand only.
10. At this time, we are not permitted to take communion to those at home. Instead, we ask that those who are able to attend Mass, please offer up your Mass for those who desire to be there but cannot.
11. We are asking for volunteers to help clean the churches immediately following every public Mass. If you are interested in helping, you can simply come to a cleaning session. No need to call ahead. Again, only 64 and under may volunteer.
12. There will be a special Mass on May 31 at 2pm at SP for those coming into the Church. More details will be sent to you from Nikki.
13. There will be special Masses for First Holy Eucharist on June 14 and June 21; both at 2pm; both at SP. Again, Nikki will be in touch with you for more details.
14. Funeral and wedding Masses can now take place again; but following all the above restrictions. Please call if you have any questions.
15. Confessions will be available in church as follows: Wednesdays from 5:30-6:30 in SP. Saturday 3-3:45 in SMM and 7-8 in SP. Sunday morning at 8am in SP. Screen only.
16. We are currently working on getting Adoration going again. More details coming.
17. Mass will still be offered on YouTube even when made open again. With this in mind, we are asking for any High School students who have an interest in filming or YouTubing if they'd like to help with these recording. The hope is that this will become a standard ministry at the parish, even when COVID 19 is a distant memory. Please send me an email at dbedel@saintpat.org if interested. 18. A reminder that there should be NO GATHERINGS ON PARISH GROUNDS other than for sacramental purposes and the soup kitchen. All other meetings should be held online if at all possible.
