

Dear Sisters and Brothers,

The Archdiocese of Indianapolis is allowing in-person meetings on parish campuses again. With that in mind, and not wanting to overwhelm our facilities with reservations for meetings, the following guidelines will be used moving forward:

1. No more than 25 people will be allowed in a space at a time. Social distancing and masks will be required. Sanitizing the space afterward will also be required.
2. Because school is in session and we are still looking for an additional custodian to help our facility manager with sanitization; we will not open the school building for in-person meetings until **March 1st**. We hope to have the position filled by then to help with sanitization of the facilities.
3. No meals, dinners, or lunches.
4. Starting **February 1st**, administrative groups can begin meeting in person. This includes Parish Council, Finance Committee, School Commission, Stewardship Committee, Facility Committee, and Liturgy Committee.
5. Starting **February 8th**, parish ministries can begin meeting in person. This includes Bible studies, Filipino rosary, quilt ministry, altar society, Stephen Ministry, military outreach, etc.
6. Starting **February 15th**, affiliated ministries can begin meeting in person. This includes Knights of Columbus, FRAYAM, Opus Dei, Catholic Charities, and any Scouts organizations.
7. It is still highly encouraged to meet digitally where possible.
8. All the above is subject to change per the Archdiocese of Indianapolis and the State of Indiana.

Starting on each assigned date listed above, groups can begin reserving dates and spaces for their meetings. Please contact the parish office to do so.
